All bidders are required to attach the proof of payment receipts on their document when submitting. Compulsory briefing Meeting : A compulsory project clarification meeting will be held on **27 June 2018** and tenders are required to meet Alfred Nzo District Municipality officials at Alfred Nzo District Municipality Conference centre in Mount Ayliff at 09:00am.

Scope of Work

The Contract shall comprise the supply of all labour, materials, workmanship, machinery, equipment, transport, attendance on others and everything stated or implied which is, or may be, necessary in and for the entire completion of all the following works:

- i. Site establishment;
- ii. Construction of 200kℓ reservoir in Clarkville and Qungebe villages;
- iii. Construction of 5.6 km village reticulation network with pipe diameters varying from 63mm HDPE to 355mm mPVC;
- iv. Installation of 60 No. of standpipes within villages;
- v. Construction of 1 No. of 500m access road to reservoir location;
- vi. Fencing of reservoir site;
- vii. De-establishment on completion;
- viii. Maintenance of the above for a period of 12 months after the issue of the Certificate of Completion;
- ix. Compliance to all relevant regulations relating to Health & Safety and Environmental Management Acts.

Notes to Prospective Bidders/compulsory submissions

All bids submitted should remain valid for a period of 90 days after the bid closing date.

- Valid SARS pin number confirmation certificate
- **All bidders should be registered with CIDB, minimum of 6CEPE or Higher is required**
- Municipal clearance certificate certifying that no municipal rates and service charges owed by the bidder and any of its directors to Alfred Nzo District Municipality or to any other municipality where the bidder's business operations are located are in arrears for more than three months.
- Certified copies of BBBEE certificate issued by a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor or a Sworn Affidavit.
- Certified copies of ID documents of members and Certified copies of original company registration documents
- The bid will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the Preferential Procurement the bidders' attention is drawn to Form MBD6.1. **Failure to submit will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level**

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- Company profile with traceable references
- Joint Venture agreement should be in CIDB JV agreement format.
- Letter of good standing from the Bank for all the tender price below R10 million
- The Alfred Nzo District Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or any bidder.
- Latest Audited Financial Statements for any tender price over R10 million
- Bids received after the published closing date will not be considered and will not be opened
- Bidders are required to submit Proposed Project Team, their CV's and qualifications.
- **All bidders should complete MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 8, MBD 9 and Ethics Commitment For Suppliers Of Alfred Nzo District Municipality**
- **Assessment bidder form should be completed and stamped by previous employer and attached with tender submission.**
- All prospective service providers of goods and services and infrastructure procurement are to be registered on Central Database in order to business with all organs of state in the Republic of South Africa.

Failure to supply all required and supplementary information will result in the tender being deemed non-responsive; and therefore the tender will not be considered for award.

Evaluation Criteria

The bids will be evaluated on the basis of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act No.5, 2000), and the regulations pertaining thereto (2011), as well as the Alfred Nzo District Municipality's Supply Chain Management policy.80/20 preference point system will be used as per the ANDM SCM Policy.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT NO 5, 2000 (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:-

The bid will be evaluated in two stages namely:

- Stage 1 – Functionality
- Stage 2 - Price and BBBEE Certification

Only Bidders who score 70% or more on stage 1 would be evaluated further and therefore eligible for the award.

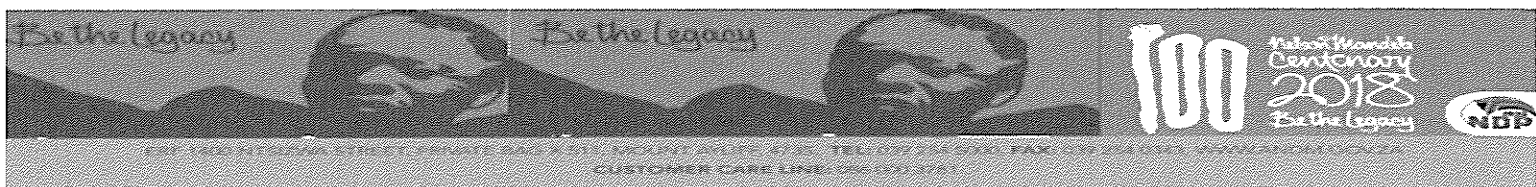


