

SCOPE OF WORK

The main purpose of this supply and deliver of Chemicals is to ensure that all Water Infrastructure remains functional; thus meaning that all chemical orders will procured through the Supply Chain Management of the Municipality by means of an order requisition. An order will be provided to the Service Provider to supply and deliver the required chemicals to the appropriate supply point.

Take note that:

- Service Provider will be provided the details of the different WTW /WWTW and oxidations ponds in the 4 Local Municipal areas of the District Municipality.
- Technical report detailing the consumption bi monthly with efficient cost of chemicals supplied versus the demand. Tabled with jar test results.

Notes to Prospective Bidders: Compulsory submissions (Failure to submit any of the following will result in disqualification)

- All bids submitted should remain valid for a period of 90 days after the bid closing date.
- Municipal clearance certificate certifying that no municipal rates and service charges owed by the bidder and any of its directors to Alfred Nzo District Municipality or to any other municipality where the bidder's business operations are located are in arrears for more than three months
- Valid SARS pin number confirmation certificate
- Certified copies of BBBEE certificate issued by a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor or a Sworn Affidavit.
- Copies of ID Documents and all submitted certificates must be certified
- The bid will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the Preferential Procurement the bidders' attention is drawn to Form MBD6.1. Failure to submit will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level
- Company profile with traceable references
- The Alfred Nzo District Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or any bidder.
- Bidders are required to submit Proposed Project Team, their CV's and qualifications.
- All bidders should complete MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 8, MBD9 and Ethics Commitment For Suppliers Of Alfred Nzo District Municipality



- Assessment bidder form should be completed and stamped by previous employer and attached with tender submission.
- All prospective service providers of goods and services and infrastructure procurement are to be registered on Central Database in order to business with all organs of state in the Republic of South Africa.

Failure to supply all required and supplementary information will result in the tender being deemed non-responsive; and therefore the tender will not be considered for award.

Evaluation Criteria

The bids will be evaluated on the basis of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act No.5, 2000), and the regulations pertaining thereto (2011), as well as the Alfred Nzo District Municipality's Supply Chain Management policy.80/20 preference point system will be used as per the ANDM SCM Policy.

Received Responsive bids will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Stage 1 Functionality
- Stage 2 Price and Preferential Points Only bidder scored a minimum of 70 out of 100 points will be considered for a Stage 2
