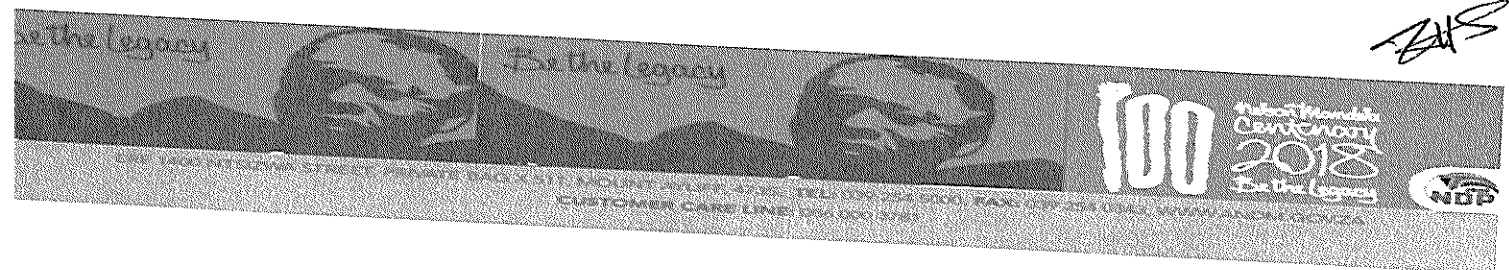

SCOPE OF WORK

ANDM had introduced the programme as an interim to intermediate spillage intervention measure that includes any of the following:

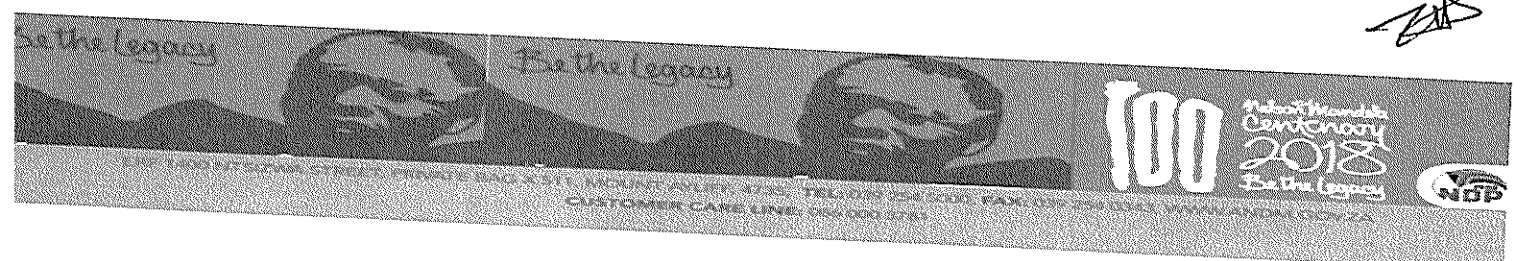
- Emptying of liquid effluent inside temporal including main concrete pond and discarding effluent in an environmentally approved procedure as directed by an independent environment management consultant.
- Creation compartment within existing concrete lined pond by construction of separation walls to aid natural settling process of solids and liquid effluent.
- Construction of chlorine dosing chamber for disinfection of liquid effluent prior to discarding to nearby natural water stream.
- Construction of artificial wetland system downstream of the chlorine dosing chamber.
- Any appropriate intervention that involves repairs or re-commission dysfunctional existing infrastructure.
- Backfill temporal pond with local earthworks/ materials and repair existing wire fence around pond area.

Notes to Prospective Bidders: Compulsory submissions (Failure to submit any of the following will result in disqualification)

All bids submitted should remain valid for a period of 90 days after the bid closing date.

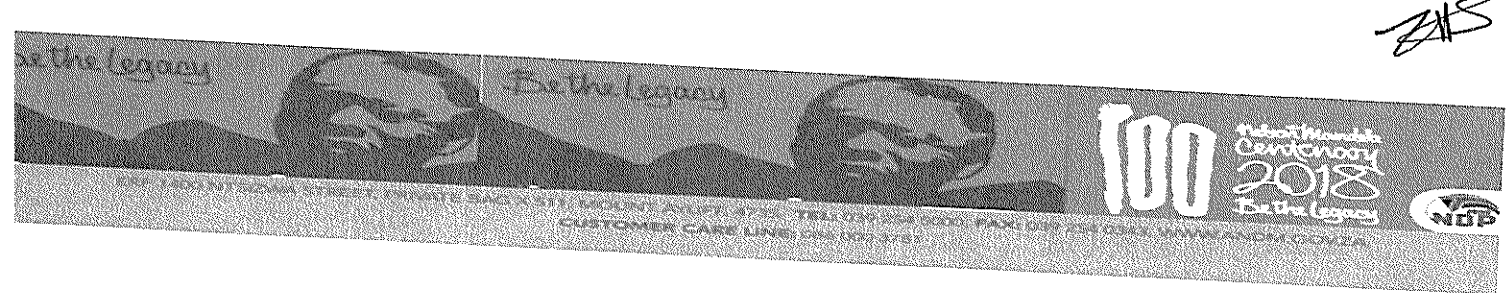
- Valid SARS pin number confirmation certificate
- **All bidders should be registered with CIDB, minimum of 3CE or Higher is required**

- Municipal clearance certificate certifying that no municipal rates and service charges owed by the bidder and any of its directors to Alfred Nzo District Municipality or to any other municipality where the bidder's business operations are located are in arrears for more than three months.
 - Certified copies of BBBEE certificate issued by a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor or a Sworn Affidavit.
 - Certified copies of ID documents of members and Certified copies of original company registration documents
 - The bid will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the Preferential Procurement the bidders' attention is drawn to Form MBD6.1. **Failure to submit will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level**
 - Company profile with traceable references
 - Joint Venture agreement should be in CIDB JV agreement format.
 - Bids received after the published closing date will not be considered and will not be opened
 - Bidders are required to submit Proposed Project Team, their CV's and qualifications.
 - **All bidders should complete MBD1, MBD 4, MBD 8, MBD 9 and Ethics Commitment For Suppliers Of Alfred Nzo District Municipality**
 - **Assessment bidder form should be completed and stamped by previous employer and attached with tender submission.**
 - All prospective service providers of goods and services and infrastructure procurement are to be registered on Central Database in order to business with all organs of state in the Republic of South Africa.
- Failure to supply all required and supplementary information will result in the tender being deemed non-responsive; and therefore the tender will not be considered for award.**

Evaluation Criteria

The bids will be evaluated on the basis of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act No.5, 2000), and the regulations pertaining thereto (2011), as well as the Alfred Nzo District Municipality's Supply Chain Management policy.80/20 preference point system will be used as per the ANDM SCM Policy.

Received Responsive bids will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

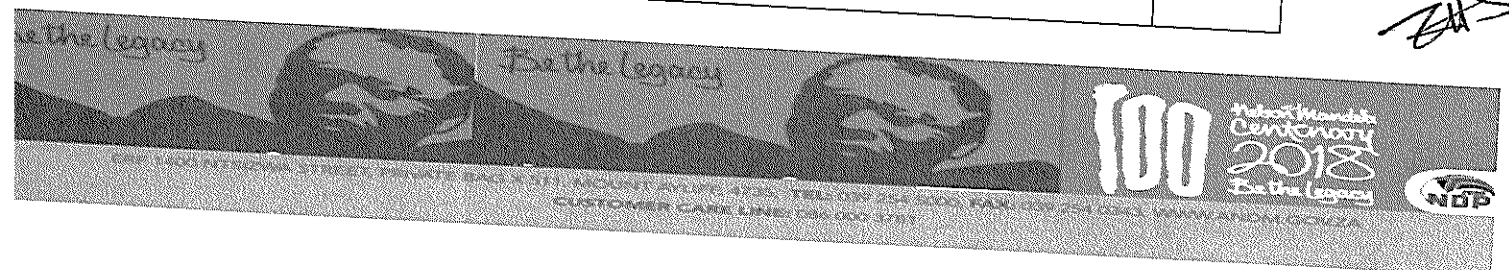
- Stage 1 – Functionality

Only bidder scored a minimum of 70 out of 100 points will be considered for a Stage 2 evaluations.


